



Thesis moves team to Gatwick for London push

Thesis Unit Trust Management (TUTMAN) is moving part of its Chichester team to Gatwick after appointing Sarah Noone as a director.

Noone, who joins Thesis from Northern Trust, will be joined by David Tyerman, managing director; Sam Butlin, investment manager; and Ed Baynton-Williams, portfolio assistant.

Tyerman said the move from Chichester to Gatwick will allow the team to take advantage of the good transport links to ensure more efficient and easy access with the London investment community.

He said: 'The appointment of Sarah and the wealth of experience she brings with her will keep TUTMAN at the forefront of new ideas for collective investment schemes, and provides us with the additional resource needed to ensure we can deliver against the high service we set of ourselves for our clients.'

TUTMAN has attracted nearly £400 million of new funds over the past 12 months.

Tyerman said this could in part be put down to the groups' development of its work in the area of Family Limited Partnerships (FLPs), which it says is seen by the legal world as a modern and flexible solution for wealthy families wanting to mitigate the impact of inheritance tax.

Tyerman said: 'At their core, FLPs are collective investment schemes. As an authorised operator of such unregulated schemes, TUTMAN has an important role to play working alongside the client's law firm in bringing these solutions to life.'
